ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS: All applicants must meet the duty eligibility standards of ANGI 36-101. Applicants must be medically qualified under provisions of AFI 48-123. Applicant must hold a minimum of Secret Security Clearance at time of application. All applicants must be fully qualified SSgt or SrA promotable, and must be fully qualified 3P051. Applicants must be in compliance with Lautenberg amendment requirements for carrying a firearm. Applicants must possess a valid civilian driver's license, and have a passing PT test.

POSITION DESCRIPTION: This position is located in the Security Police functional area of the 103rd Airlift Wing and its purpose is to provide physical protection for assigned aircraft within the confines of the 103rd Airlift Wing Ramp. As assigned, the incumbent would also function as the alarm monitor. Patrols on the rotational basis or serves as a fixed post to provide close-in, close boundary and perimeter protection of the unit's non-alert aircraft, from the dangers of sabotage, espionage, armed intrusion and other willful or accidental destruction.

The application packet will consist of the following documents:

1. One signed original NGB Form 34-1 (Application for Active Guard/Reserve Position).
2. Report of Individual Person (RIP)
3. Passing report of individual Fitness results from the Air Force Fitness Management System (AFFMS) (not more than 12 months old).
4. AF Form 422 Notification of AF Member's Qualification Status
5. Statement of all active service performed. Any of the following documents may be used: NGB Form 23 or 23b, DD Form 214, or DD Form 1506 (Statement of Service).
6. Copy of State Civilian Driver's License
7. Certificates of Training applicable to advertised position
8. Overgrade Letter of Understanding (If applicable)
9. Professional resume including duty history.

*All applications must be received in AGR Tour Branch no later than 1600 hours on the closing date of the announcement. **Applications received after this time, regardless of postmark will be considered ineligible.** Applications must be hand carried or mailed to the AGR Tour Branch at the above address.*

SELECTION PROCEDURE: All application packets that meet eligibility requirements will be forwarded to the selection board IAW ANGI 36-101. Applicants that do not meet eligibility requirements will be notified in writing as to why. Selection for this position will be based on qualification/fitness, and without discrimination because of race, religion, color, national origin, sex, political affiliation or any other non-merit factor. All applicants will receive written notification of the final action on their application.
