**ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:** All applicants must meet the duty eligibility standards of ANGI 36-101. Applicants must be medically qualified under provisions of AFI 48-123. Applicant must hold a minimum of Secret Security Clearance at time of application. All applicants must be fully qualified SrA to SSgt promotable, and must be fully qualified 2A651H.

Technical School may be required for AFSC's 215XX/2A6XX.

**POSITION DESCRIPTION:** The primary purpose of this position is to maintain, troubleshoot, remove, repair, install, certify, test and perform operational checks on the turboprop engines, propellers, and associated propulsion system components. Work involves the maintenance, troubleshooting, repair, overhaul, modification and testing of conventional, modified, and experimental aircraft engines, their components, assemblies, and subassemblies. It also covers work involving engine accessories such as starters, generators, anti-icers, and fuel control devices when such assignments are incidental to work on the completed engine. Works also involves the review of engine/component records to determine cause of failure and the extent of disassembly and repair required in returning engine and/or component to operational condition. Performs operational checks of installed propellers, engines, auxiliary power units and sub-systems during aircraft maintenance ground runs in accordance with approved checklists. Performs isochronal and special evaluations on engines, propellers and auxiliary power units. Performs aircraft full power runs and complete engine and propeller efficiency checks. Prepares man-hour data collection and required forms for input into the Core Automated Maintenance System (CAMS) or the G081 (AFI 22-2101, CAMS for Mobility). Provides on-the-job training for assigned personnel. Prepares for and participates in various types of readiness evaluations such as Operational Readiness Inspections, Inspector General and Unit Evaluation Inspections, mobility, and command support readiness inspections, mobility, and command support exercises.

1. One signed original NGB Form 34-1 (Application for Active Guard/Reserve Position). Add **primary email** address in Current Home Address Line".
2. Report of Individual Person (RIP)
3. Passing report of individual Fitness results from the Air Force Fitness Management System (AFFMS) (not more than 12 months old).
4. AF Form 422 Notification of AF Member's Qualification Status
5. Statement of all active service performed. Any of the following documents may be used: NGB Form 23 or 23b, DD Form 214, or DD Form 1506 (Statement of Service).
6. Copy of State Civilian Driver's License
7. Certificates of Training applicable to advertised position
8. Overgrade Letter of Understanding (If applicable)
9. Professional resume including duty history.

\*All applications must be received in AGR Tour Branch no later than 1600 hours on the closing date of the announcement. **Applications received after this time, regardless of postmark will be considered ineligible.** Applications must be hand carried or mailed to the AGR Tour Branch at the above address.\*

**SELECTION PROCEDURE:** All application packets that meet eligibility requirements will be forwarded to the selection board IAW ANGI 36-101.
