ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS: Must be AOC qualified (graduated OBC). Must be able to become 12A AOC within 18 months. Must possess or be able to possess a secret security clearance.

POSITION DESCRIPTION: The 192nd EN BN AGR Training Officer is the principal staff officer responsible for all matters concerning training, operations, and plans at the battalion level. Responsible for integrating and synchronizing operations for the commander. Ensures warfighting function integration and synchronization across the planning horizons in current operations integration, future operations, and plans integrating cells. Directs and supervises daily operations of the Battalion CP. Develops long term Training Guidance and Calendars to support the units' ARFORGEN Cycle, Mission, and METL. Primary participant during the Staff's Command Estimate Process, including mission/risk analysis, individual staff estimates, and OPLAN/OPORD development. Responsible for all battalion level coordination of all external and internal training support including ranges, training site locations, transportation, and RMFSS reservations. Responsible for allocating and forecasting ammunition in TAMIS. Provides oversight for commander's PME program. Oversees six unit Training NCO's and assists the Administrative Officer in his absence.

Emailed application will not be accepted (exceptions may be made for Soldiers deployed OCONUS only).

The application packet will consist of the following documents:

- a. One signed original NGB Form 34-1 dtd 20131111 (Application for Active Guard/Reserve Position). Add **primary email** address in "Current Home Address Line".
- b. **CERTIFIED** copy of Officer Record Brief (ORB).
- c. Copy of Personnel Qualification Record (PQR).
- d. Copy of most current Medical Operational Data System (MODS) Individual Readiness Record. PHA must be current within 12 months, and HIV should be 2 years of closing date.
- e. Statement of all active service performed. Any of the following documents may be used: NGB Form 23 or 23b, DD Form 214, or DD Form 1506 (Statement of Service).
- f. Copy of last five (5) OERS. A letter of recommendation must be submitted on Officers not requiring an OER. **Any** missing evaluation periods must be substantiated with a memo addressed to the president of board explaining any missing periods.
- g. Copy of most recent DA Form 705 ("**RECORD**" APFT Scorecard, not to exceed 12 months).
- h. Copy of DD 5500 or DD 5501 (Body Content Worksheet) (**if applicable.**)
- i. Copy of State Civilian Driver's License.
- j. DA Photo, or Photograph in Class A Uniform, or photo in Army Service Uniform taken within the last 12 months.

*All applications must be received in AGR Tour Branch no later than 1600 hours on the closing date of the announcement. **Applications received after this time, regardless of postmark will be considered ineligible.** Applications must be hand carried or mailed to the AGR Tour Branch at the above address.

SELECTION PROCEDURE: All application packets that meet eligibility requirements will be forwarded to the selection board IAW Chapter 2, NGR 600-5. Applicants that do not meet eligibility requirements will be notified in writing as to why. Selection for this position will be based on qualification/fitness, and without discrimination because of race, religion, color, national origin, sex, political affiliation or any other non-merit factor. All applicants will receive written notification of the final action on their application.
