WHO MAY APPLY:

Must be a current on-board CTARNG AGR within the grade(s) of E4 and E5.

AREA OF CONSIDERATION: This position is open to the grades of: E4 to E5. Individual selected will receive an AGR Tour with the Connecticut Army. In order to be considered for this position's applicants must meet minimum qualifications as outlined on this announcement.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING: The documents listed WILL be submitted "AS A MINIMUM". If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief letter will be submitted citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the Soldier as eligible. Failure to do so may result in a finding of ineligibility and may cause the applicant to lose consideration for this position.

1. Signed original NGB Form 34-1 dtd 20131111 (Application for Active Guard/Reserve Position). Add primary email address in "Current Home Address Line". Application packet will consist of the following documents IAW AR 135-18 and NGR 600-5.
2. Copy of DA Form 1059 demonstrating required professional military education qualification for your GRADE
3. VALIDATED copy of Selection Board Record Brief (ERB) (dated within 30 days of closing date). IAW PPOM #20-026
4. ASVAB Line Scores (i.e ERB, DD 1966)
5. Statement of all active service performed. Any of the following documents may be used: NGB Form 23 or 23b(within 12 months of closing date), all DD Form 214s, or DD Form 1506 (Statement of Service).
6. Copy of last five (5) NCOERs. In the event you do not have the required five NCOERs due to Time in Service (TIS) and Time in Grade (TIG), Letters of Recommendation (LOR) / DA 1059's / E4 Evaluations must be submitted in the absence of the evaluations, to substantiate a total of five documents. All LOR's MUST be signed. Missing evaluation periods not due to TIS/TIG must be substantiated with a memorandum addressed to the president of board explaining the missing periods. Must be a total of 5 documents.
7. Proof of current Security Clearance. Submit favorable NACLCL memorandum from State Security Manager Office dated within 60 days from advertisement. Failure to submit Certificate of Clearance, will result in being ineligible for consideration.
8. Individual Medical Readiness Record (IMR) within 12 months of closing date. IAW AR 600-110, HIV test no older than 24 months from closing.
9. DA Form 705 (Must say "Record" APFT on scorecard, cannot be prior to 1FEB19 for M-Day and 1AUG19 for AGR's). Passing ACFT also acceptable.
10. Copy of favorable DA 5500 or DA 5501 (Body Content Worksheet) dated w/in 12 months. (If not applicable, upload DA 705 with passing ht/wt or memo/document stating it does not apply)
11. Copy of COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card or an approved/pending exemption.

POSITION COMPATIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

The individual(s) must qualify for and be placed in the following compatible MOS/AOC: 31K2

MINIMUM APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:

1. Any MOS may apply for consideration. If not 31K qualified, Applicant must meet minimal requirements to obtain MOS at time of application: (a) A minimum score of 95 in aptitude area ST in Armed Services Vocational aptitude Battery (ASVAB) tests administered prior to 2 January 2002. (b) A minimum score of 92 in aptitude area ST on ASVAB tests administered on and after 2 January 2002 and prior to 1 July 2004. (c) A minimum score of 91 in aptitude area ST on ASVAB tests administered on and after 1 Jul 2004. Meet mandatory training requirements of AR 190-12, CH 3 & 5.
2. Applicant must successfully complete the Military Working Dog Handler Course, Lackland AFB, TX within one (1) year of appointment
3. Minimum rank eligible to apply for this position is SPC/E4.
4. Must possess a SECRET Security Clearance.
5. HRO is not required to review application prior to the closing date on the announcement; hence, it is imperative the application is complete and correct when submitted. (Read INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING carefully)

BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:

Responsibilities

- (1) Groom their assigned MWD daily.
- (2) Maintain MWD kennels daily.
- (3) Perform physical conditioning training with assigned MWD.
- (4) Perform additional kennel duties as assigned.
- (5) Provide mission briefs to senior leadership highlighting the dog's capabilities.
- (6) Meet mandatory training requirements as depicted in chapters 3 and 5 of AR 190-12.
- (7) Maintain appropriate training records as depicted in appendix B of this regulation.

(8) Enforce kennel standards in accordance with unit standard operating procedures (SOPs).

Be able to lift and carry up to 75 lbs.
